Worship Committee Procedures

The worship committee ensures that UUCV has consistently excellent worship by supporting worship when Rev. Aija is present and leading worship when she is absent. The participation of the worship committee ensures that UUCV hears multiple voices and perspectives from the pulpit. Multi-vocal worship embodies the ideas of a covenanted community that upholds the priesthood of all believers rather than a top down theology that emphasizes one voice.

The Worship Committee helps to coordinate the planning of worship services. Worship Associates act as liturgists during regular and special worship services. The Worship Associates are also lead worship on the Sunday's that Rev. Aija is out of the pulpit. The worship committee also meets monthly for training, to offer feedback and support and to plan the upcoming worship schedule.

The worship committee:

Meets monthly to discuss previous worship service and plan for upcoming services.

Offers constructive feedback to each other and Rev. Aija.

Provides Sunday worship that deepens the spirit and engages our minds.

Works to sharpen our liturgical skills and practices.
